

CREDIT GUIDELINES

FILM/TELEVISION/MOBILE PHONE PRODUCTION

Every project needs to be delivered with a full credit list, which should be the same as it appears on the screen. Preferably, credit everyone involved at the end of the film and try to keep the credit sequence as short as possible (around 30 seconds max).

You also need to credit Mediabox after the credits with a Mediabox logo (**available under Project Guidelines section of the website**). Please note, due to the legacy of Mediabox, do not reference the Department for Children, Schools and Families or Department for Education.

RADIO

A full credit list needs to be delivered with the programme. In a piece of radio fiction, for example, only key contributors (artist, producer, director) should be credited and try to do this in a concise and interesting way. In a factual piece, the reporter should introduce him/herself and any key contributors within the narrative of the piece.

Furthermore, please use the following wording to credit Mediabox: "This programme was brought to you by Mediabox, a programme that enables young people to create media projects and get their voices heard."

INTERACTIVE

A full credit list needs to be delivered with your project. Within your project, provide a link to a webpage which lists the credits and please credit Mediabox with the Mediabox logo, ensuring that the logo hyperlinks back to the Mediabox website www.media-box.co.uk (**available under Project Guidelines section of the website**).

PRINT

You must attach a full credit list to your project. Scale your credits to the size of your project. Introduce key creative and editorial input with the title of the piece if wished and technical crew where relevant at the end of the publication.

Ensure that Mediabox is credited with the Mediabox logo whenever your project goes to print (**available under Project Guidelines section of the website**).
